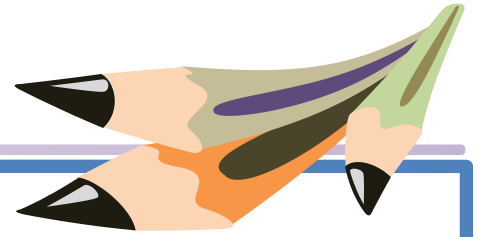
School Association
