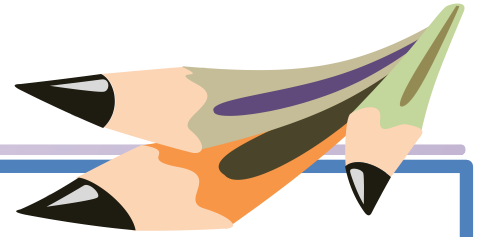
Year 6 SATS Club sessions will continue to be held on Thursdays at Scorton until SATS week beginning 14th May.
