The School Association are hosting a Race Night on Friday 9th March in Calder Vale Club. This is a fun social event with refreshments and a bar to raise money for school funds.

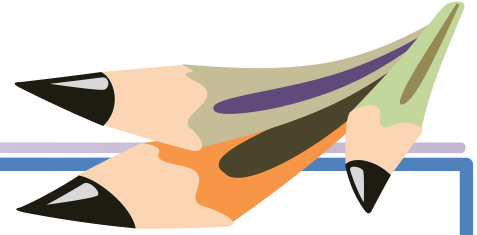
Calder Vale Festival
